



7) Questions & Answers

Mr. BILTERYST presented the design of the school bus body logo, featuring the logos of both the German and French schools. The design serves as a dynamic advertisement, promoting the Eurocampus concept and mission across Shanghai. Notably, the French school opted to use its English name instead of the French version to enhance recognition among a broader audience. This strategic decision has already generated attention, with the French school being featured in short videos by key opinion leaders (KOLs).

The parent representative once again raised whether DSS school will conduct student school bus safety training together with LFS this year.

Mr. Bonga pointed out that he has already communicated with the DSS management team, and this year the two schools will jointly provide students with safety training for transportation.

Every Friday, we hold a school bus weekly meeting with our supplier PEIXING to promptly summarize any issues that arise during the week and optimize our services.
